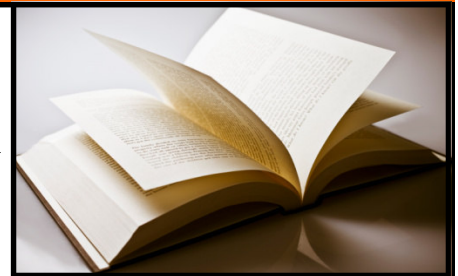

WHAT'S YOUR STORY?

"I wish before God," replied Paul, "that whether easily or with difficulty, not only you but all who listen to me today might become as I am—except for these chains.
Acts 26:29



In Acts Chapter 26 Paul delivers his personal testimony to King Agrippa's court. Dr. Wilton's message this week pointed to three key components of this testimony that revealed God's transforming power in Paul's life: (1) Who he was before he knew Jesus, (2) How he gave his heart to Jesus, and (3) What he had become as a result of inviting Jesus into his life. In this passage Paul tells the story of how his life has changed since entering into a relationship with the Lord Jesus.

Have you ever thought about your story? If we look at the components in Paul's testimony as chapters in our lives, then what chapter are you in. Chapter 1—you haven't trusted Jesus as your Lord and Savior. Chapter 2—you just gave your heart to the Lord and are beginning an exciting new relationship with Him. Chapter 3—you are growing in your relationship with Him. This week reflect on the Chapters in your life. Can you tell a difference between Chapter 1 and Chapter 3? Identify those Spiritual Milestones in your life where your relationship with God changed or grew to a new level.

Share Your Story...

God began your story when He knit you together in the womb. Today is your opportunity to share it with your family.

As a family take turns sharing what chapter of

your life you are in with regards to your relationship with Christ. You might be surprised at how God has been working in your home.

Sharing your testimony with friends and family is a great

practice for when you may be in the presence of a King Agrippa and have to share your story with others who may not have a relationship with God.
